SOCIETY ACT

CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is The Nanaimo Oldtimers Hockey League.
2. The purposes of the society are:
 - (a) To foster, promote, encourage, improve and perpetuate among the Members of the Society and others with an interest in ice hockey;
 - (b) To promote and encourage increased recreational activity and physical fitness among its members;
 - (c) To promote athletics and education, and to arrange games, matches and competitions, and to offer, grant and contribute toward prizes, awards, distinctions, scholarships, and bursaries;
 - (d) To promote and encourage strong and lasting fellowships and goodwill among its members;
 - (e) To promote and encourage sportsmanship in all of its activities;
 - (f) To promote and encourage the affiliation and co-operation of the society with other recreational organization for the benefit of its members; and
 - (g) To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above purposes.
3. The activities, organizations and operations of the Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the Society shall be used solely in carrying out its purposes. This provision is unalterable.
4. In the event of the winding up or dissolution of the Society, the funds and other assets of the society remaining after all debts and liabilities of the Society have been paid, or provision for payment has been made, shall not be distributed among the members but shall be paid, transferred and delivered to such organizations as may be determined by a prior special resolution of the regular members of the Society at or near the time of winding up or dissolution. This provision is unalterable.
